
## About 18,000 Mysterious Sightings Spotted On a World Map



## Canadian Survey Reveals an Increased Number of UFO Sighting Reports

Quebec is on top of the list with the most sightings of unidentified flying objects (UFOs), according to the 2015 Canadian UFO Survey.

Winnipeg-based Ufology Research conducted the survey and released the result on Monday. It says that the year 2015 had the second-largest number of sightings in the last 30 years with 1,267. Second only to a whopping 1,981 sightings in 2012, which was also the alleged year of the end of the world based on the Mayan calendar.

Newfoundland, Nova Scotia, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, and Alberta reported more sightings in 2015 than the year before, but Quebec comprises for around 35 per cent of all reports last year.

The number of reported sightings in Quebec was way up from previous years when it was only responsible for between five and fifteen percent.

Montreal has 97 reports; Toronto, 78; Vancouver, 69 and Edmonton with just 36 sightings.

The survey reveals that most sightings last about 16 minutes and over 50 percent of the reports were of simple lights in the sky.

The research noted that UFO sighting reports remain high because of several reasons, including better access to reporting sightings, more secret military flights, or the downturn of the economy that causes people to look upward for assistance.

The study also admitted that no concrete evidence of the involvement of extraterrestrial contact of some UFO cases. The continued increase of reported UFO sightings from the public suggests that further examination of the phenomenon by physical, medical and social scientists is needed.

# Exopolitical Prospects Based on Dr. James W. Deardorff's article "Possible Extraterrestrial Strategy for Earth"



Dr. James W. Deardorff, a Professor Emeritus of Atmospheric Science published "Possible Extraterrestrial Strategy for Earth" in the Royal Astronomical Society, Quarterly Journal (ISSN 0035-8738), vol. 27, March 1986, p. 94-101. Dr. Deardorff's Summary in "Possible Extraterrestrial Strategy for Earth" reads as follows:

"The arguments are reviewed which hold that our Galaxy is nearly saturated with extraterrestrial life forms, that our existence requires in hindsight that they were and are benevolent toward us, and that our lack of detection of them or

communications from them implies that an embargo is established against us to prevent any premature knowledge of them. An inconsistency is detected, in that any sudden lifting of the embargo in a manner obvious to the public would cause societal chaos and possibly touch off a nuclear exchange, while any communications received via radio telescope would likely be either quickly confiscated by government agencies and not revealed to the public, or heavily censored. The inconsistency is that the advanced civilization should be expected to have planned some other strategy, if it is actually benevolent, experienced and intelligent.

It follows that any embargo not involving alien force must be a leaky one designed to allow gradual disclosure of the alien message and its gradual acceptance on the part of the general public over a very long time-scale. A possible strategy for their accomplishing is proposed."

Dr. Deardorff should be considered a pioneer in exopolitical thinking. As he suggests, advanced extraterrestrial intelligence may abound in the galaxy and UFO evidence suggests that it is quite reasonable to suppose that it is already here operating here on Earth. However, it would be operating under its own terms while using a technology that — under our prevailing understanding — would seem surreal or like "magic." Dr. Deardorff also explores the idea that societies which develop practical interstellar 'travel' may have a tendency to overcome self-destructive behavior and would operate under a more comprehensive ethics respectful of less developed civilizations and that, for this reason, they might not be willing to unequivocally disclose their presence to humanity until we become capable of handling it.

If extraterrestrial life abounds in the galaxy (as it is becoming ever more probable under conventional astronomical research on exoplanets) and some of it is — relatively speaking — at least 100's of years more technologically advanced than Earth's humanity, these intelligent life forms may find ways to overcome spacetime limitations (including vast distances, inertia and energy constraints) in a way that would seem 'magical' and even 'impossible' to many of us. In fact, it would particularly seem way to 'weird' and 'magical' (and thus completely noncredible) to scientists required to operate with classical, scientifist, materialist, objective mindsets under a politically and socially controlled mainstream institutions expressing a culture that reflects a sense of superiority by distinguishing itself from previous magical and religious ways of 'making sense' of reality.

However, the best objective UFO and contactee evidence gathered from around the globe in over 7 decades (an evidence which can be segmented into various categories that reinforce each other) also scientifically and reasonably adds up and provides credence to some version of the "extraterrestrial hypothesis" and, to a sufficiently informed, intelligent, open-minded person, it also reasonably indicates the likelihood that one or more technologically advanced non-human intelligences are already here and, furthermore, perhaps interacting in various semi-covert ways with our planetary and societal systems.

If being able to achieve practical interstellar "travel" is accompanied by a TENDENCY to overcome intra-culture, destructive divisions, these extraterrestrial civilizations (or at least most of them) might be underscored in various degrees by a basically shared, post magical and post classical form of ethical thinking, perhaps essentially based on a practical emphasis on cooperation itself relying on the recognition of an intrinsic level of connectivity fundamental to the existence of physical reality whilst within and beyond it. Thus (perhaps after carefully monitoring our species and its social and psychological responses and after some initial attempts at open contact perhaps during the Eisenhower Administration and early "contactee era" in the 1950's), in order not to destructively disrupt human society, they (one or more extraterrestrial groups) might generally have chosen to act under a "strategy" which could be called an "embargo strategy" or, more precisely, a "leaky embargo strategy." They would try to avoid social disruption by gradually manifesting to various persons around the globe without doing it in unequivocal ways that cannot not be plausibly denied by prevailing scientists and other cultural leaders closely associated with effective political power.

The extraterrestrial intelligences enforcing this "embargo" would, nonetheless, also realize that humanity — as a complex living system and "Holon" — has reached a threshold in which there's a need to acknowledge the truth about its origins and position in the cosmic scheme of things in order to evolve into a unified planetary and cosmic civilization which understands itself as participating within an even grander and interrelated cosmic whole.

Perhaps amidst a divided world in which the UN only represented a forum for independent nation-states, as the leader of the most advanced nation-state on Earth President Eisenhower was — in the minds of extraterrestrial representatives — the most adequate person to establish formal contact with. Perhaps for them, his response would weigh heavily on what course of action to proceed. Perhaps they recognized the need for worldwide education and disclosure but understood that

the procedure would depend upon this President's reply. Thus, maybe even after heeding to President Eisenhower's alleged rejection of leading an educational, paradigm-shifting revelation of the ET presence inclusive of its operative cosmic principles, these ETs decided to continue "leaking" away their presence in a way that would still allow ruling cultural elites to deny, suppress or rationalize it while gradually cajoling the rest of society to acknowledge them.

I posit that most or all extraterrestrials capable of overcoming spacetime limitations too practical, long distance interstellar 'travel' also enjoy a share, basic ethical understanding and way of thinking, feeling, being and acting which is today quietly arising on Earth in some quarters but which is still not prevalent. It is a step closer to unity and non-dual existence and may express in different forms. For instance, emphasizing a feeling-based, ethical perspective, it could be called a "fourth dimensional level of consciousness" as shared by contactee Sixto Paz Wells. It may also be associated with a higher cognitive capacity as a "5th, 6th (or higher) Order of Consciousness," as Harvard developmental psychologist Robert Kegan proposes. A "trans systemic," "multi systemic" or "complex" form of epistemological understanding should be required ("complex" meaning "interwoven" as proposed by French philosopher Edgar Morin). Some of these advanced thinkers emphasize the deep feeling of respect, love and interconnectivity associated with this level of sentient evolution but this level also provides other aspects such as the required meta theoretical or structural map, greater self-identity inclusivity and more inclusive ways of valuing. A humanity, civilization or species cohesive and respectful of its own members and correspondingly protective of its planetary base would have achieved the initial stage of this level of development.

Furthermore, accepting multiple realities, psychic powers and the extraterrestrial presence should also eventually be a crucial part of this so-called "Second Tier" level of development in consciousness or in the capacity for thinking, feeling, being, integrating and disclosing reality co-creatively as proposed by integrative and evolutionary philosopher Ken Wilber. Some individuals may be at ease with the feeling-based aspect or with the psychic, paranormal and extraterrestrial aspects but not with the intellectual aspects coming together in this level of development but, eventually, all of these aspects should be integrated in the human body-mind-spirit complex to wisely relate with our ET "visitors."

Individuals operating under this (now largely segmented but steadily emerging) level of human development emphasized by these and other thinkers at the

forefront of cultural awareness would also have to feel resonant with the non-physical valuing the crucial importance of the existence of multiple interactive realities. By comprising the importance of the psychic, the "paranormal," the non-physical and the forthcoming universally recognized extraterrestrial presence (the latter unfolding under its own "transdimensional" (or trans-reality) terms we may be able to activate transdimensional technologies and practically overcome physical limitations and along with it the primitive mindset of intrinsic separation that goes with it. Again, promoting the psychic and otherworld as per human faculties and understanding may be quite necessary in order to function "transdimensionally" and to understand what our cosmic "visitors" are about and doing whether it doesn't coincide with prevailing academic attitudes and expectations. We would need to be at ease with how the non-physical can be used to manipulate the physical. Perhaps non-physical "dimensions" overlap spacetime physical ones interiorly and a two-way exchange is possible.

Dr. Deardorff's "leaky embargo" hypothesis is probably connected with extraterrestrial disclosure exopolitician Stephen Bassett's concept of a "truth embargo" quite likely performed and perpetuated under intelligence and counterintelligence parameters by powerful (both non-constitutional and semiconstitutional) elements within (and associated to) the U.S. Government and in cahoots with a few other major world governments in association with militaryindustrial and specific secretive civilian power elites. This "truth embargo" would have occurred after an initial minor level of admittance or of 'disclosure' was allowed in tentative ways by a few government representatives in the 1940's and 1950's. The "leaky embargo" hypothesis allegedly conducted by extraterrestrials may also be associated with the idea of there being "secret government" factions amicable to a gradual disclosure or educational process through movies and other means (some of which may have been overtaken by the strategy to over-present extraterrestrials as hostile in order to prepare the public to eventually declare a false-flag invasion). This may be due to the fact that – at least since Eisenhower's alleged first contact (in 1955 at Muroc/Edwards AFB) with a benevolent ET group not willing to hand out technology whilst proposing the suppression of nuclear explosions – there could be a coincidence or concordance between secret, gradual exopolitical disclosure policy (with a spin) and the extraterrestrials policy of gradually disclosing their own presence. This is indeed a complicated situation in which "those in the know" appear to operate perpetuating archaic, "us vs. them," power-group-competing levels of consciousness.

Dr. Deardorff's "leaky embargo" hypothesis would also relate with disclosure and civilian contact activist extraordinaire Dr. Steven Greer and his strong position on the universal benevolence of all extraterrestrial civilizations visiting Earth. This would be given that in "Possible Extraterrestrial Strategy for Earth" Dr. Deardorff lends credence to C. Sagan and W.I. Newman's idea that civilizations with a long history might have "impediments against cosmic imperialism and perhaps a Codex Galactica to educate the younger societies on how to behave. Moreover, Dr. Deardorff also echoes astronomer and cosmologist E.R Harrison's idea that there might exist a "biogalactic law" wherein civilizations which are destructively aggressive tend (my emphasis) to wipe themselves out in the solar system of their birth and do not go on to colonize the galaxy." However, in the latter case, the word "tend" is important because it is not used to allude to an unequivocal outcome. In other words, some advanced ET civilizations may have avoided selfdestruction by strengthening an ethics of internal or intra-cultural, intra-societal coherence but nonetheless be possessed by an expansive nature or other influential elements from their own developmental history that lead them to attempt overtaking other planetary civilizations.

However, in Dr. Deardorff's article there's a chapter titled "The Degree of Extraterrestrial Benevolence," in which he highlights that, due to a huge number of civilizations and hugely varying degrees of evolution expected a "wide range of extraterrestrial benevolence should be expected." He refers to the possibility that "some small fraction of the races in the Galaxy could well be considered hostile by us but be held in check by one or several more benevolent civilizations which for some reason have an interest in either the planet Earth or its inhabitants" and I tend to find this position reasonable. It doesn't blindly over idealize the extraterrestrial presence or condemns it and quite favorably corresponds with some credible, previous and contemporary contactee messages such as those by Sixto Paz Wells and Ricardo Gonzalez. Moreover, it seems to also correspond well with some of the statistical findings in the four-part survey conducted by the Dr. Edgar Mitchell Foundation for Research on Extraterrestrial Encounters (FREE) in that most of their ET encounters are (thus far by June 2016) not considered as "negative" by experiencer survey respondents. Additionally, the fact that – as far as we know – we have not been overtly invaded, enslaved, attacked or destroyed by an ET civilization could not only be due to the fact that most do not wish act like that but to the possibility that there might be a monitoring, policing and protective alliance preventing rogue extraterrestrial elements from doing it.

If we consider valid the aforementioned "leaky embargo" hypothesis and also valid some of Dr. Michael E. Salla's research on the various alleged secret space programs (based on alleged whistleblower testimony), it would seem that some of the extraterrestrial groups associated with at least some of these space program developments would resonate with a more classic form of dichotomous, conflicting and highly polarized human behavior. This would seem to contradict the expectation that beings capable of overcoming spacetime limitations would operate under a more inclusive form of consciousness, logic and ethics but, on the other hand, it might be that we are dealing with entities that sufficiently operate at that level by maintaining internal societal cohesion in a mental manner and still be able to operate transdimensionally to varying degrees by over-relying on consciousness-enhanced technology, even if some may have disconnected their feelings and other qualities also associated with higher levels of consciousness and development.

If – regarding some of the more recent whistleblower stories or, rather, I'd say...sagas – we are not dealing with a typical movie-like, American space age, male fantasy or with some sort of counter-intelligence disinformation combined with some genuine disclosures and/or leaks, some of the ETs would have supplied technology to covert human groups extending classical militaristic human behavior into a post classical space-age. This may or may not be true. There might be actual perceptions of truth talking past each other. I'm attempting to analyze many possibilities without a fixed mindset.

Parts of the more incredible warring stories by alleged whistleblowers like Randi Cramer and Corey Goode may have been validated by other perhaps more credible whistleblowers like William Mills Tompkins and Clark McClelland. If these reports represent facts (reports which include secret space programs from different human factions also conflicting with each other) at least some of the extraterrestrials associated with some or all of different secret space programs would also represent what has been known as a "service-to-self" mode of being and perhaps others would simply be limited to a level of evolution still too close to old-fashion warring human tendencies. The secret access to initial-level, transdimensional technologies would have linked us with low-level, conflicted ETs.

In spite of serious critics against the "negative ET hypothesis" like Dr. Steven Greer (doing a great job in many respects), the existence of negative ETs or what could

be called "service-to-self" extraterrestrials are not only implied in sagas like the Mahabharata but also mentioned by several contactees like Sixto Paz Wells, Ricardo Gonzalez and, more recently by Alejandro Gonzalez and Erick Romero from Mexico. In such cases, these ETs would also be operating "transdimensionally" under a more inclusive form of science and logic, but their negativity would not impede them to do this. Moreover, according to several contact accounts, the logic by which even these extraterrestrials varieties operate force them to respect free will once they have not been able to cajole, deceive or paralyze in fear.

If we are not simply anthropocentrically projecting all-to-human, war-like expectations on extraterrestrials, then at least some aspects of the alleged secret space programs would have attracted extraterrestrials groups with unresolved human-like problems. It could be an issue of "like attracts like." Yet still, some other ET groups might have pressing needs such as physical, mental, and reproductive atrophies for which they may have taken upon themselves to utilize human resources obtaining some sort of permission or leniency in exchange for technology. In this latter category might be ET groups associated with President Eisenhower's alleged 1955 second physical encounter at Holloman AFB after he had allegedly rejected in 1954 the educational offer given by a more service-to-others, benevolent extraterrestrial group of ambassadors.

What to believe about the variety of interpretations regarding the ET presence? Recent experiencer-contactee polls suggest that MOST ET contacts are not regarded as "negative" by experiencer-contactees. As in many complex things in actual, practical experience, it may not be an issue of "either-or" but of "bothand." There are many preferences, beliefs and positions within the ufological, experiencer, experiencer research, disclosure and exopolitical communities and we need to be careful not to offhandedly dismiss positions that – due to our own preferences – seem preposterous. Although some information might actually be wrong and some might be disinformation, we need to be able not to react offhandedly for or against these within the disclosure, UFO, exopolitics, experiencer and experiencer research communities. We need to be able to withhold judgment until we have reasonably sufficient information, especially if these explanations appear to conflict with ours. We must avoid becoming "compartmentalized" or "boxed-in" within our preferred interpretations about the whole phenomenon, ourselves unsuspectedly acting like the very closed-minded academics we often criticize for offhandedly dismissing conventional nonconventional ufological evidence and explanations.

ET groups seem to come with many inherent tendencies, needs and intentions. Besides being able to function under a deeper understanding of connectivity, they may have overcome their own self-destructive, internal disagreements by various means like genetic engineering out strong emotions, becoming less individualistic or exerting telepathic social control. If we accept the often shared message that they are normally clearly divided into "service-to-self" ("dark" or spiritual energies-"stealing" or absorbing) and "service-to-others" ("luminous" or spiritually radiant) behavioral-existential modes while Earth humanity is unique in that it holds both polarities in an indeterminate manner, our leap forward may require us to demonstrate a way of transcending extreme polarization without losing spiritual-ethical sentiments or feelings and other subtle "heart-based" human qualities that many extraterrestrial civilizations seem to have lost in various degrees.

Would extraterrestrials not amicable with the highest possible intentions for humanity still be able to come in and interact? Would some of them be acceptable while others possibly harmful? If there were a quarantine imposed on Earth, it may not apply to close-to-human-behavior, conflict-ridden, ET factions (and possible intra terrestrial associates) if they had already been active on Earth before the imposition of that quarantine. They would have a "right" to nonetheless interact with us, albeit with the provision that their actions do not exceed the boundaries that would prevent all other extraterrestrial forces from pursuing their goals. I understand that the last few paragraphs are plain exopolitical speculation but, nonetheless, it is based on the plausible information presented by research such as Dr. Salla's, a research in which several whistleblower sources with various degrees of credibility (although some may originate in counter intelligence efforts) seem to coincide. Extraterrestrial battles among opposing extraterrestrial groups may be a reality (albeit with multiple degrees of crudeness and sophistication) in transdimensionally functional civilizations IF they are able to follow more meta systemically complex and inclusive rules of engagement. This situation might have been extended too extraterrestrial-related, secret space programs especially if officially non-existent, technological elite groups have obtained their technology by making contact with ET groups closer too human mental and behavioural patterns.

There may be reasonable and truthful ways to harmonize various allegedly irreconcilable extreme views regarding what can be considered by some a plausible or alleged presence whilst by others an actual and obvious extraterrestrial presence. I hope to have been able to illustrate how Dr. James W.

Deardorff's "leaky embargo" hypothesis still provides us with a general conceptual, non-extremist, reconciling interpretive context useful to conceptually harmonize many exopolitical possibilities.

'Hidden' Agenda of China's Mission to Unexplored Far Side of the Moon – "Site of Solar System's Largest Impact Crater




China will launch a mission to land on the dark side of the moon in two years' time, state media reported, in what will be a first for humanity. The moon's far hemisphere is never directly visible from Earth and while it has been photographed, with the first images appearing in 1959, it has never been explored. Earlier reports from the Xinhua news agency hinted that China may be considering the construction of a pioneering radio telescope on the moons virgin far side, which will give it an unobstructed window on the Cosmos that was confirmed this June, 2016 when an agreement was announced between the Netherlands and China, that a Dutch-built radio antenna will travel to the Moon aboard the Chinese Chang'e 4 satellite and usher in a new era of radio astronomy allowing for the study of objects that might otherwise be invisible or hidden in other parts of the electromagnetic spectrum.

"Radio astronomers study the universe using radio waves, light coming from stars and planets, for example, which is not visible with the naked eye," commented Heino Falke – a professor of Astroparticle Physics and Radio Astronomy at Radboud University. "We can receive almost all celestial radio wave frequencies here on Earth. We cannot detect radio waves below 30 MHz, however, as these are blocked by our atmosphere. It is these frequencies in particular that contain information about the early universe, which is why we want to measure them."

The Chang'e-4 probe -- named for the goddess of the moon in Chinese mythology - will be launched to it in 2018, the official Xinhua news agency reported. "The Chang'e-4's lander and rover will make a soft landing on the back side of the moon, and will carry out in-place and patrolling surveys," according to the country's lunar exploration chief Liu Jizhong.

Beijing sees its military-run, multi-billion-dollar space program as a marker of its rising global stature and mounting technical expertise, as well as evidence of the ruling Communist Party's success in transforming the once poverty-stricken nation.




But for the most part it has so far replicated activities that the US and Soviet Union pioneered decades ago. "The implementation of the Chang'e-4 mission has helped our country make the leap from following to leading in the field of lunar exploration," Liu added.

In 2013, China landed a rover dubbed Yutu on the moon and the following year an unmanned probe completed its first return mission to the earth's only natural satellite. Beijing has plans for a permanent orbiting station by 2020 and eventually to send a human to the moon.

Space flight is "an important manifestation of overall national strength", Xinhua cited science official Qian Yan as saying, adding that every success had "greatly

stimulated the public's... pride in the achievements of the motherland's development."



Clive Neal, chair of the Lunar Exploration Analysis Group affiliated with NASA, confirmed that the Chang'e-4 mission was unprecedented. "There has been no surface exploration of the far side," he told AFP Friday. It is "very different to the near side because of the biggest hole in the solar system -- the South Pole-Aitken basin, shown above, which may have exposed mantle materials -- and the thicker lunar crust". The basin is the largest known impact crater in the solar system, nearly 2,500 kilometers wide and 13 kilometers deep.

## "I Saw Structures on the Moon" (Karl Wolfe)



The following account has been addressed several times before, and I have had it in my notes for quite some time. The recent interest in the Space program and questions about our future goals in space have caused me to dust it off. I believe it will be of interest to our viewers.

This extraordinary story comes to us from one Karl Wolfe. Wolfe worked for the Director of Intelligence at Headquarters Tactical Air Command, Technical Group. The fantastic events explained here occurred while he was stationed at Langley Field, Virginia.

Langley Field was center for information received from the Lunar Orbiter Project. Satellite receivers from around the world waited for information from the Orbiter, and it was then channeled to Langley, where the information was transformed into photographic images, and other top-secret data. The photographic imaging was

done at a secure military lab ran by NSA. In an interview for UFO magazine, Wolfe asserted that he was one of only two technicians at Langley with high enough security clearance to work with the high-tech photographic equipment which processed info from U-2 spy planes, and other military intelligence hardware.

#### Wolfe, in his own words:

... At any rate, I was in a color lab one day when my boss, Staff Sergeant Taylor, came over to me and said that they were having a problem with some equipment on the base and it was the first lunar orbiter program, where thy had a mission to pretty much locate the first landing sites for the 1969 lunar mission for the astronauts.

So he said they were having some problem with equipment over there. It was similar equipment to what we had- it was computerized contact printing equipment. He wanted to know if I would go over and take a look at it. He said to me, it's an NSA facility. At the time, I didn't know what the NSA was--I was pretty naive.

I thought he said NASA. So in my mind, for a long time I thought it was a NASA facility that I had gone to, but I remembered him saying NSA and converting it in my own mind to NASA...

Wolfe claims that one day when NSA photographic equipment failed, he was called in to assist them with the critical repair work needed to keep the machines on the job. Coincidentally, Wolfe was the only individual available at the time trained in the type of equipment that had failed. He normally would be crossing lines by venturing into NSA territory.

His security clearance status was raised to enable him to even enter the highly secure laboratory.



Wolfe's heart raced as he entered the here-to-fore forbidden hangar that day, and he was shocked to see the frantic activity in the lab, activities carried out by individuals of many different nations. Wolfe had naturally thought that only American citizens would be in the NASA lab, but there were many individuals with guest name tags on, and obviously from foreign countries present this day, inferring that they were there on a temporary basis for some special occasion.

## If Aliens Ever Attack Earth, We Need to Protect the Moon or Die Trying





In the world of science fiction, when aliens attack the Earth, they often go after another rocky sphere. That would be the moon, our planet's only natural satellite. Although there are exactly zero humans currently residing on the moon, zero pieces of essential equipment or instruments (although let's be real, those lunar go-karts are pretty dope) situated on its surface or its orbit, and no concrete sense of whether it possesses

any valuable resources, the moon is essential to our species' survival on this planet. If hostile aliens were to blow it to bits or cause some serious damage to it, human would be in serious trouble — even if we managed to successfully repel an extraterrestrial threat.

The moon has played a key role in shaping the way natural processes of Earth, and it continues to do so today. The moon is thought to have been formed just a mere 30 million years after the Earth (which itself is 4.53 billion years old). Since then, the moon's single greatest (and most obvious) effect on the Earth has been the mediation of the ebb and flow of tides on the planet's bodies of water.

Scientist believe that in the infancy of this relationship, the moon's distance from Earth was half of what it is today — and this resulted in much more extreme tides. These tides drove heat from the equator to the poles, leading to ice ages. These glacial shifts spurred more rapid migratory patterns in various species, resulting in a more diverse array of life around the globe. In fact, because of how important water is to molecular processes in primitive life and organic materials, tide shifts may have acted as a kind of natural way for those chemical reactions to get rid of or acquire water in the formation of basic structures like nucleic acids. In other words, tides may have jumpstarted or encouraged the evolution of life on Earth.



#### Because it's gone forever.

Okay, that's a pretty cool history lesson, but what about today? What exactly would be the biggest impact on our lives today if the moon disappeared or had a chunk ripped out from itself?"

"We'd lose the normal rhythm of tides," says Noah Petro, a research scientist at NASA Goddard Space Flight Center who works with the Lunar Reconnaissance Orbiter. He tells Inverse we'd probably lose the large tides we're used to on a day-to-day basis, and instead experience "smaller tides, caused by the Earth's rotation with the sun."

The most noticeable effect this would have is that we'd see oceans around the world level off, to a certain extent. While initially that might save coastal communities from having to deal with potential floods during high-tide, it would also mean they would lose the benefits of low tide. That would wreak havoc on clams, which would have a cascading effect on underwater ecosystems as well as the beachside food shacks worldwide.

Furthermore, the moon plays a significant role in distorting water around the equator. Without a natural satellite, that water would probably redistribute itself around the poles. This might seem like a good thing for coastal cities by the ocean that are constantly threatened by rising floods. But this is awful for bodies of water inland that are fed by oceans. We might see estuaries — responsible for desalinating water naturally — dry up or become significantly reduced. Rivers and lakes further inland would also shrink by quite a bit.

Unless we manage to make artificial desalination technology viable, we'd see the whole world inundated by water shortages — and that's already a problem much of the world is currently contending with.

Petro also cites two other significant effects the moon's vanishing act would have on Earth. "The moon stabilizes Earth's orbit," he says, "so

we'd see changes to the climate we're currently used to." He points to Mars as an indicator of what we might see. Mars doesn't have large moons like Earth's to affect its axial tilt as much, so the red planet is stuck with very long ice ages.

On Earth, there would be a significant amount of long winters, and "a general cooling off," of the world at first, he says, perhaps followed by a warming. We'd see "wild extremes" that are more drawn out and last much longer than the planet has previously exhibited. Petro emphasizes that these climatic effects would certainly not be felt immediately — they would occur on a scale of 1,000 to 10,000 years. But there is one other effect that humans would have to find solutions to very quickly if the moon were blown up or hit with some sort of explosive force: debris.

A lot of material, he says, would be expelled into Earth's orbit, and some of it might even push through the atmosphere and strike the surface. If that debris were big enough, we'd basically deal with a catastrophic scenario of falling moon rocks that not even Brian May would be able to fix.

Let's also not forget the fact that orbital debris is also an increasing threat to the world's satellite currently zipping around the globe. Some of those instruments are extremely important to communications systems used by governments and militaries. If aliens fired a bunch of missiles at the moon, we can basically kiss those satellites goodbye. Hopefully we have a few landlines still lying around as a backup.

"Fortunately, we don't expect the destruction of the moon to happen," Petro added, laughing.

## KIC 8462852: No signals from 'alien megastructure' star but a big breakthrough in hunt for ET

Meti president Douglas Vakoch discusses the latest observations from Boyajian's star

Ever since The Atlantic drew attention to an erratic star by the name of KIC 8462852 back in October 2015, astronomers have been baffled, as they've tried to come up with an explanation for its quirky dimming pattern.

In a paper published in The Astrophysical Journal Letters, our team led by Ben Schuetz, director of the Boquete Optical Seti Observatory in Panama, asked whether an advanced civilisation in the vicinity of KIC 8462852 might be sending us intentional, brief laser pulses. Though we didn't find any evidence of ET, we confirmed an innovative new approach to searching for intelligence beyond Earth — a strategy that's fitting for a search that could take generations to succeed.

The anomaly in this star's behaviour was discovered by NASA's Kepler spacecraft, which searches for planets around distant stars by detecting miniscule dips in the starlight that reaches our solar system. Each time a planet passes between its parent star and the Kepler spacecraft, there's a diminution of light that's so small it would be missed by Earth-based telescopes, unless they knew exactly what to look for.

Far beyond Earth's atmosphere, the Kepler spacecraft picks up subtle variations in light. Once a planet passes around its star three times, the spacecraft can pick up the pattern, signaling the existence of an exoplanet - a planet that orbits another star (not our Sun).

#### Blocking out the light

The anomalous light curve of KIC 8462852 was discovered by astronomer Tabetha Boyajian, who led a citizen science project capable of finding dimming patterns

that don't conform to the expectations of Kepler's automated computer programs. In short, human eyeballs were able to see a dimming that Kepler's sophisticated algorithms missed. How come? Because the dimming of Boyajian's Star didn't conform to the expectations of astronomers.

The unusual feature of Boyajian's Star is that the dimming doesn't happen regularly, and the diminution in brightness is massive. Whereas even a huge, Jupiter-sized planet travelling between a distant star and the Kepler spacecraft would reduce the star's brightness by less than 1%, at times Boyajian's Star dims by over 20%.

What's causing this? Astronomers have been scrambling to come up with a natural explanation. Bradley Schaefer has found that Boyajian's Star has been dimming over the course of the past century, though groups led by Michael Hippke and Michael Lund have challenged his analysis. The search for a convincing natural explanation continues.

In parallel, one early hypothesis by Jason Wright was that the dimming might be caused by an alien megastructure orbiting Boyajian's Star, created by an advanced extraterrestrial civilisation. Which led Seti scientists to wonder: 'If there are engineers building massive structures around KIC 8462852, might they also be

sending us intentional signals by radio?' A search conducted at the Seti Institute's Allen Telescope Array in northern California found nothing.

We took the next logical step and asked whether an advanced civilisation in the vicinity of KIC 8462852 might be sending us intentional, brief laser pulses. We conducted the search at about the worst possible time – in late October and throughout November of 2015 – during Panama's rainy season. But on a half dozen nights during those weeks, the night sky was clear for an hour or more at the same time the star was up, so we could search for these powerful but quick pulses of light. As expected, we didn't find signs of alien intelligence signaling its existence. But we did accomplish something else. We showed you can do a serious optical Seti experiment on even a modest-sized telescope, like the one we used in Panama – a half meter in diameter.

One of our most startling discoveries — as we wrote up the results of our experiment — is that although the observatory we used in Panama has a much smaller aperture than the telescopes used by many optical Seti projects, we had comparable sensitivity to detect signals. This is due to the innovative signal processing system we used to look for brief laser pulses, developed by Ben Schuetz. The standard approach, used to detect brief laser pulses in most past optical SETI experiments, is to split the incoming photons into two or three streams, to see whether photons are arriving within the same window of time at multiple, separate photon detectors. That's unlikely to happen by chance, if the photons are created by nature, so if it happens, it's evidence the signals may be from another civilisation.

The downside of splitting the beam into multiple streams, however, is that this reduces the number of photons reaching any given detector, therefore reducing the sensitivity.

At the Boquete observatory, we used a single photomultiplier that was able to detect two or more pulses arriving within a 25-nanosecond window. It's highly unlikely that would happen if the photons were all coming from Boyajian's Star, and if it had happened, it would be suggestive of an intentional signal from ET. But even that would not be convincing, because when we make a lot of observations of natural objects, sometimes even rare events will happen just by chance.

To help rule out a natural origin for a group of pulses arriving at the Boquete telescope at about the same time, we added a second step. We looked for a periodic repetition of pulses. We don't know of natural sources of repeating pulses at such short timeframes, so if we had found this repetition, we'd either have discovered ET, or we would have found some radically new natural phenomenon.

The good news is that this two-step process has a very low rate of false positives. Over the course of looking at more than 3,000 stars over a five-year period in Panama, only one such repeating signal was detected. Because we couldn't detect it again, we assume it was not a real signal from another civilisation, but a rare false positive.


No aliens yet, but plenty of scope for the future

We didn't discover evidence of ET signaling from Boyajian's Star, so our search continues, focusing on red dwarf stars relatively near to Earth. This is a search that could take generations, so we've also launched a summer internship program at the Boquete Observatory, to help prepare future Seti scientists. Our current intern is Julia Sullivan, a Physics and Astrophysics major from the University of Birmingham in the UK, who is helping to improve the method used to generate test signals, essential to maintaining the sensitivity of the system. In parallel, she is developing her skills in science communication by participating in the Blue Marble Space Institute of Science's Young Scientist Programme.


Nestled within our recent paper's detailed description of the electronics for detecting laser pulses and the logistics of making observations, we also highlight the value of modest-sized observatories for Seti. This opens Seti to serious amateur astronomers — the sort of committed observers who have long contributed the scientific studies of variable stars — letting us continue the search even during times when major funding for Seti observations becomes scarce.

Historically, Seti has used a model of Big Science, with an emphasis on using the largest possible telescopes. While that strategy works well when the funding is strong, we need a complementary strategy of using a global network of modest-sized observatories as we prepare for the long haul. This is critical as we consider ways to sustain Seti on the timescales of centuries or millennia, which is one of Meti International's priorities.

### New Clues to Ceres' Bright Spots and Origins



NASA's Dawn spacecraft has been taking images of Ceres, the largest body in the asteroid belt, since December 2014. As Dawn's orbit brought it closer to the dwarf planet's surface, a mystery appeared: Ceres has bright spots. Over 130 separate areas on Ceres, reaching up to 6 miles wide, shine out from their dark surroundings. After months of study and speculation, scientists have confirmed that the brightest spots are made of sodium carbonate, making Ceres' Occator Crater the largest deposit of this sort of mineral ever found beyond Earth.



Since images of the bright spots were released, scientists and the public alike have speculated about what they could be: NASA even created a poll to gather opinions. At first, the leading theory suggested that the bright spots were expanses of water ice, either brought to the surface by volcanic activity or revealed by an impact. Even as evidence mounted that the spots were made of some sort of mineral salt, more and more ideas, ranging from the plausible theory that Ceres was covered in an ice mantle just below the surface to the fanciful notion that the spots could be a shining alien city.

Until June, no clear answer revealed itself. According to Andreas Nathues of the Max Planck Institute in Germany, "The main problem we had [analyzing the bright spots] during approach phase was that our spatial resolution was too low." Because Dawn's instruments were calibrated based on Ceres' darker surface, the images didn't capture any detail in the bright areas. "In June, we divided our exposure times for

the bright spots and the dark surface. Then the spatial resolution started to become sufficient to identify what the spots are," Nathues said.



As Dawn and its newly-calibrated cameras approached Ceres, details of the bright spots came into focus. "Dawn has transformed what was so recently a few bright dots into a complex and beautiful, gleaming landscape," said Marc Rayman, Dawn's chief engineer and mission director. Now, two new studies, published in Nature and Nature Geoscience, have concluded that Ceres' bright spots are sodium carbonate and that Ceres is much drier than previous observations led scientists to expect.

On Earth, sodium carbonate is primarily found in hydrothermal environments, where hot water leaks from the planet's crust. Similarly, the sodium carbonate on Ceres appears to have welled up from deeper inside the planet, suggesting that its interior may be warmer than scientists previously thought. The sodium carbonates also serve as a clue that Ceres once had liquid water below its surface: author of the Nature study and Dawn scientist Maria Cristina De Sanctis said, "These minerals can be formed only in a liquid water environment."

However, the study found no evidence for water in any of Ceres' craters: if there was a subsurface ocean (or subsurface puddles) there, it either froze or disappeared millions of years ago. Ceres even has less ice than expected, according to the study in Nature Geoscience, led by Michael Bland of the US Geological Survey. "Before Dawn's arrival there was this expectation that Ceres would be relatively ice-rich," Bland said, but when the spacecraft got there it found topographical features indicating that Ceres' subsurface is under 40 percent water ice by volume. That could be enough water to aid in the formation of carbonates, but it would have to be liquid and Ceres has a temperature of -105 degrees Celsius.




A topographical map of Ceres. (Credit: Source.)

As Nathaus expressed, "it's very hard to explain carbonates in these amounts. This is still a mystery." The results published in these two studies "are two pieces of the puzzle, and . . . there's still work to be done to link them together," Bland said. The Dawn spacecraft will continue to collect puzzle pieces for the remainder of its mission, as NASA recently decided that it will remain at Ceres rather than moving on to other objects in the asteroid belt.

"It's amazing how much we have been able to learn about Ceres' interior from Dawn's observations of chemical and geophysical properties. We expect more such discoveries as we mine this treasure trove of data," said Carol Raymond, deputy principal investigator for the Dawn mission. The data will keep pouring in; it's up to scientists to piece it together.

## Russian Ufologist/Biologist Spotted Saucer Landed in 1980

Although the leaders of the former Soviet Union did not allow citizens to speak about UFOs, there have been significant UFO cases being surfaced since then it fell. 
He spent his life investigating the UFOs. In his large apartment, he even created an established that is laboratory equipped with old tools and 1,000 samples of materials, which can be found at the nearby sites. According to him, the space visitors use geological fissures to orientate themselves about the Earth before descending. Dalnegorsk County is believed to be an anomalous zone and is popular for its 14 cave. According to Dvuzhilny, a UFO was observed on January 29, 1986, in the Vysota-611 Mountain nearby Dalnegorsk. Burned fragments found therein revealed the silicon shales and rare-earth metal lanthanum discharging magnetic radiation. Pavel Reshetnikov, the head of the anti-aircraft forces was invited to the conference, in which he participated in 1995, but was prohibited from leaving the country due to his military status. Later on, he confirmed that a mysterious object tracked over the Amur River by the radar in the early 1990s. According to Reshetnikov, it could not be readily identified by the naked eye as either a plane or a missile.

The sample found at the site became subject to numerous scientific tests, which includes isotope analysis. The samples found 50 kilometers away were burned at a temperature beyond 2,000 degrees C. According to Dvuzhilny, comprehensive analysis of the burned metal pieces were influenced by the extraterrestrials. Despite modest laboratory tools, he still lacks funds to complete his scientific activities. However, he is not giving up, in fact, Dvuzhilny is currently preparing an expedition to the Amgu territory.

# Seth Shostak: We will find aliens in the next two decades

Meeting ET isn't so far off, I can bet my coffee on it, says astronomer who has dedicated his career to seeking out life on other planets

Astronomer Seth Shostak believes we will find ET in the next two decades; he has a cup of coffee riding on it. But don't interpret such modest stakes as scepticism — the-72-year-old American has made it his life's work to listen for life beyond Earth, and, according to the man himself, just isn't the sort to bet a Maserati. Shostak has spent the past 25 years of his career at the Search for Extraterrestrial Intelligence (Seti) Institute in California, where there are 42 antennas poised to pick up alien communication. He believes that Earth-like, habitable planets might not be rare at all; there could be billions.

"It doesn't seem unreasonable to think that we are not alone, if all those planets are completely sterile, you've got to think, wow there must be something really special and miraculous about Earth – but generally those people are not scientists," he says.

"Finding life beyond Earth would be like giving Neanderthals access to the British Museum; we could learn so much from a society that is more advanced than ours, and it would calibrate our own existence."

Astronomy was a childhood interest for Shostak. He remembers picking up an atlas (he was very interested in maps) and becoming enthralled by a solar system diagram at the back. By age 10 he had built a telescope. And it was the sci-fi films being made during those formative years which sparked his interest in aliens. "Those movies really scared me, they made me ill all night – but I explained to my mother that I just had to see them," he says, citing War of the Worlds, It Came from Outer Space and I Married an Alien as memorable childhood hits.

At 11, Shostak began making alien films of his own with friends; The Teenage Monster Blob, Which I Was, starred an alien monster made out of six pounds of Play-Doh. "When I was first making films, we tried to make serious drama. But audiences laughed, and we switched to making comedies and parodies," he says.

Today he is called upon for his alien expertise by directors making sci-fi films and television shows. Contrary to said films and shows, he doesn't spend his days sitting around with earphones on, straining to hear a signal. If you looked in at Shostak's office during most days, you'd find him attending to that universal chore of the modern world: email. Apparently, even intergalactic explorers have admin. But he says the most productive hours of his day are spent discussing strategies with his Seti colleagues, writing articles about their research, and producing a weekly science radio show.

Is ET likely to look like he does in the Spielberg movie? Probably not. Any encounter is more likely to be with something post-biological, according to Shostak. Movie-makers are sometimes disappointed by that answer. "I think the aliens will be machine-like, and not soft and squidgy," the scientist says. "We are working on the assumption that they must be at least as technologically advanced as we are if they are able to make contact. We aren't going to find Klingon Neanderthals – they might be out there, but they are not doing anything that we can find."

ET aside, aliens are invariably depicted as hostile, and intent on wreaking destruction. The new Independence Day sequel is no exception. "Films [like Independence Day] speak to our hardwired fears – but I worry more about the price of popcorn in the cinema," says Shostak. Other scientists – including Stephen Hawking – have cautioned that making contact with aliens could be dangerous, but as Shostak points out Seti isn't broadcasting messages, it is just listening.

"I don't share those concerns anyway – any society that has the ability to send rockets to earth is centuries ahead of us – at least – and will already know we are

here. We have betrayed our presence with radio signals since the second world war.

"Besides, I doubt aliens would drop what they're doing to come over here and wipe out Clapham Junction — why would they do that? They probably have what we have at home — except for our culture, maybe they are big Cliff Richard fans or like our reality television."

Shostak is pretty relaxed about the film industry playing fast and loose with science. He doesn't mind that "Professor Fudnick" and "Doctor Fliebelveitzer" do not address one another by their first names, as normal scientists do. And there are some practical things he has helped with, like cooking up an excuse as to why a dead alien in Green Lantern looked so much like a human.

"Only about 30% of the advice I give is actually incorporated somehow into their films," he says. "But that is okay – the goal is to get kids interested in science and give it some emotional appeal." A high percentage of scientists have their initial interest in the field sparked by popular culture – film and television – according to Shostak. "I give talks at schools, and when I ask who believes in aliens, every hand shoots up, because – what kid isn't interested in aliens?"

Alien-obsession certainly never left Shostak. After studying physics at university as an undergraduate, astronomy sucked him back in. "I signed up to do physics at grad school but walked into an astronomy classroom within the first few weeks and saw the pictures on the wall; nebuli, galaxies, planets, the 200-inch Hale Telescope, all that appealed to me a lot more than physics did, so I switched classes." He went on to specialise in radio astronomy – which complemented his interest in electronics – and spent 13 years working at a Dutch university, before returning to the US and being approached by Seti.

Work is never boring for Shostak, discoveries are being made all the time and technology advances every year, which keeps things exciting. Plus, he has that cup of coffee to look forward to. Until then, he'll keep shooting for the stars.

Was North America once inhabited by a race of giants? According to an old legend supported by several challenging archaeological finds, it is possible.

Many Native American tribes tell stories about the long-forgotten existence of a race of humans that were much taller and stronger than ordinary men. These giants are described as both brave and barbaric and legends often mention their cruelty towards whomever they pleased.

The Paiute, a tribe that settled in the Nevada region thousands of years ago, have an outstanding legend about a race of red-haired giants called the Si-Te-Cah. The ancestors of the Paiute described them as savage and inhospitable cannibals.

In the Northern Paiute language, 'Si-Te-Cah' literally means 'tule-eaters.' Legend has it that the giants came from a distant island by crossing the ocean on rafts built using the fibrous tule plant.


The tribes then sealed off the mouth of the cave so that no one might set eyes on those who had once plagued their land. They were all but forgotten until a random event brought them back to light.
